

Welcome to Filey Swimming Club!

Our aim is provide instruction in swimming and related activities for local children and adults of all ages and abilities in a friendly and safe environment and there are a few things you need to know.

We are a non-profit making organisation run entirely by volunteers. Your membership and session fees go towards paying for the hire of the pool, lifeguard cover, ASA membership & insurances and training costs for teachers and helpers.

We are affiliated to the Yorkshire Amateur Swimming Association and have adopted the ASA policies on Child Protection, Ethics and Equity. In common with most clubs we do have rules (see attached). These are primarily aimed at ensuring the safety of your child and others at all times and it would help our teachers greatly if you would please ensure your child understands and abides by these rules so that we do not waste valuable lesson time.

Our teaching groups follow the ASA national teaching plan and the sessions are taken by ASA qualified teachers (at various levels). We also run A and B Squads which aim to develop the skills learned in the teaching groups, training at least twice a week and competing in local league galas.

In addition to formal lesson and training sessions, we run two leisure sessions on Tuesdays and Sundays for members– please see the website for times. The Sunday sessions tend to be popular with families but can only run if they are supported by sufficient members to cover the cost of the pool hire and life guard.

One final plea, we always need more volunteers. The majority of our volunteers came into the Club as interested parents and if you can help in any way, with the social committee, fundraising, timekeeping at galas or if you would like to be involved in teaching or on the committee, please speak to Jo.
